Privacy Policy

E-Mails

We use and collect this information to provide our partners and other users with the most efficient, enhanced, and personalized service.

We will collect and retain such information in accordance with the purposes users provided it, and with our legitimate business interests.

Sharing of Information

We do not sell or rent your personal information. We may share your information with:

 Trusted service providers (e.g., website hosting or analytics services). Legal authorities, if required by law or necessary to protect our right

Who provides us with data and other information?

Most often, we collect data and information directly from the individual who engages with NES Consulting, such as users of the platform, customers or partners.

What do we do with data?

Where is personal information transferred and stored?
